The number of people who harvest wild and country foods in Newfoundland and Labrador is relatively high compared to other parts of Canada. The number of people fishing, foraging, and hunting and trapping in the province is the highest in Canada.

Fishing 44.2%	21.9% above the national average
Foraging 39.3%	22.9% above the national average
Hunting 20.2% Trapping	14.3% above the national average


